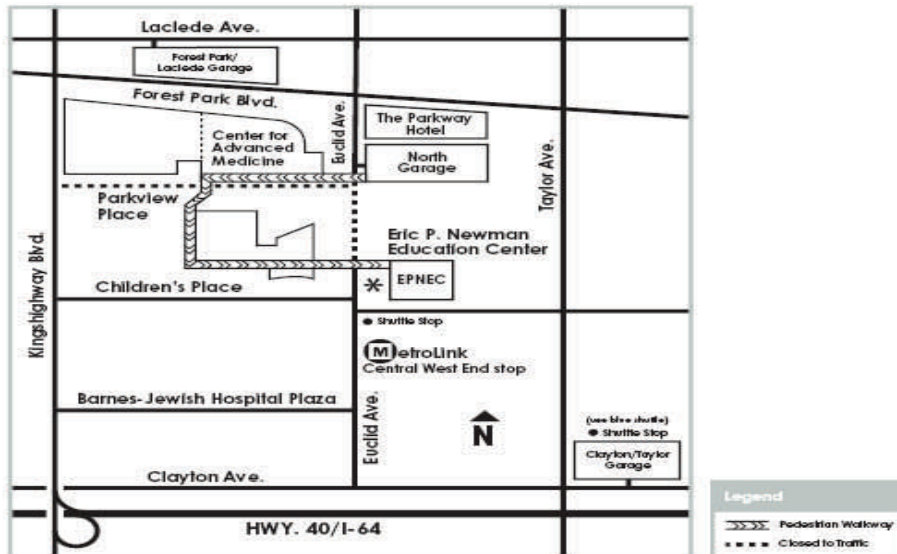

From the Airport:

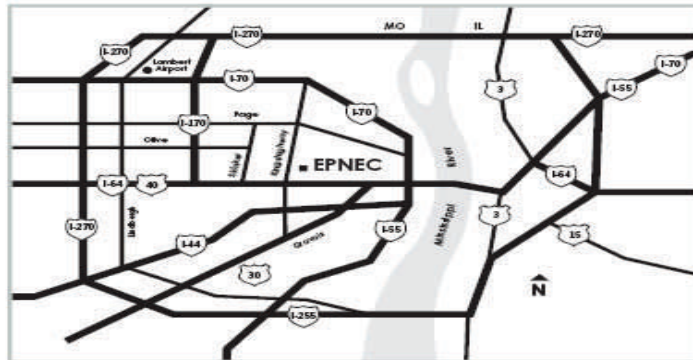
- I-70 east to I-170
- I-170 south to I-64, U.S. 40
- I-64, U.S. 40 east to Kingshighway North exit
- Kingshighway north to Children's Place
- Right on Children's Place to EPNEC

From Downtown, Illinois and points east:

- I-64, U.S. 40 west to Kingshighway
- Kingshighway north to Children's Place
- Right on Children's Place to EPNEC

Via MetroLink:

- Detrain at the Central West End stop.
- Ascend stairs to Euclid
- North (right) on Euclid to EPNEC
